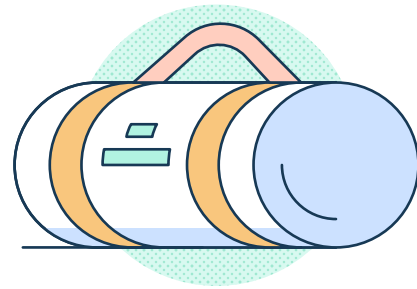


NATURAL DISTASTER Supply Kit Checklist

Make sure to have **these essential items** on hand in case a natural disaster strikes.



Have enough supplies to last at least three days.



Pack items in one or two easy-to-carry containers.

Essentials

Most important items to include:

- Cash
- Flashlight
- Extra batteries (*don't use candles*)
- Radio
(*battery operated or hand-cranked*)
- Whistle
- Medications
- Gasoline (*if you have a vehicle*)

Food & Drink

Include non-perishable items:

- Protein or fruit bars
- Peanut butter
- Ready-to-eat canned food and can opener
- Crackers
- Bottled water
(*1 gallon per person per day*)
- Utensils

Documents

Keep in a waterproof container:

- Medical records
- Insurance cards
- Copy of Social Security card
- Copy of birth certificates
- Extra sets of keys
- Bank information

First Aid

Add these items in case of injury:

- Sterile gloves
- Antibiotic wipes or cleansing agent
- Adhesive bandages
- Scissors
- Pain reliever such as aspirin



Personal Items

Ensure you have these items:

- Hygiene items, such as toothpaste, soap, and toilet paper
- Seasonal clothing items (e.g., raincoat, sturdy shoes)
- Medications
- Items for children, such as toys
- Masks
- Blankets

Pet Care Items

Pack these items if you have a pet:

- Dry or canned pet food
- Water
- Service animal I.D. if applicable
- Veterinary records
- Medications
- Leash
